



# 2019 VRHA YEAR END AWARDS



The VRHA Hi Point year begins January 2019 and ends November 2019  
Double Hi Points will be awarded at the January & November 2019 shows  
Riders must be a financial member of the VRHA at the time of showing to be eligible to receive points.  
Riders must have competed at a minimum of three (3) VRHA shows  
One horse – one rider combination must have competed in the class a minimum 3 times to be eligible  
for an award  
(VRHA State Championship Show is not included as a show attended for the 3 show requirement)

Hi Points will be determined by the number of entries in the class  
Eg: 10 entries in the class; 1<sup>st</sup> place = 10 points down to 10<sup>th</sup> place = 1 point  
Tied placings will receive equal place points.  
A zero score will receive 1 point for competing in the class

Points will be awarded on a 'one horse-one rider' combination from the following classes;

Non Pro  
Intermediate Non Pro  
Limited Non Pro  
Prime Time Non Pro  
Rookie L1  
Rookie L2  
Youth 13 Years & Under  
Youth 14 -18 Years  
Novice Horse Non Pro L1  
Novice Horse Non Pro L2

Points will be awarded to the 'horse' from the following classes;

Open  
Intermediate Open  
Limited Open  
Rookie Professional  
Novice Horse Open L1  
Novice Horse Open L2

The highest total points from each division will receive a Hi Point Champion Award  
Runner Ups will receive Runner Up aAward

In the event that a final equal score results, the winner will be determined by the highest aggregate scores over the year in that class. Year End Awards based on NRHA Handbook
