



# 2012 VICTORIAN REINING HORSE ASSOCIATION GREEN RIDER END OF YEAR HI-POINT CHALLENGE & BEGINNER END OF YEAR HI-POINT CHALLENGE RULES & CONDITIONS

All riders and horse owners must be financial members of the Victorian Reining Horse Association at the time of showing to be eligible for VRHA 2012 Green Rider End of Year Hi Point Challenge Award & Beginner End of Year Hi Point Challenge Award. Hi Point year begins at the 1st January 2012 and ends with the last show of the calendar year. Green Rider & Beginner eligibility applies as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012 as per VRHA Non Sanctioned rules. Should a rider become ineligible throughout the season the rider is unable to continue competing in that class for the remainder of the season with the exception of the final show where the winner of the Green Rider End of Year Hi Point Award and the Beginner End of Year Hi-Point Award will be challenged for.

The winner of the Green Rider class from each show held throughout the season will be eligible to compete for the Green Rider End of Year Hi-Point Award at the final show of the season, the highest placing Green Rider out of the seasons winners competing at the final show will become the winner of the Green Rider End of Year Hi-Point Challenge. Eligible Green Riders will be awarded prizes from 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place at the VRHA End of Year Hi-Point Awards Presentations. 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive a Hi-Point Challenge Trophy Rug.

The winner of the Beginner class from each show held throughout the season will be eligible to compete for the Beginner End of Year Hi-Point Award at the final show of the season, the highest placing Beginner Rider out of the season winners competing at the final show will become the winner of the Beginner Rider End of Year Hi-Point Challenge. Eligible Beginner Riders will be awarded prizes from 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> place at the VRHA End of Year hi-Point Awards Presentations. 1<sup>st</sup> place will receive a Hi-Point Challenge Trophy Rug.

## Green Rider

**VRHA GREEN RIDER:** Open to any rider that has not won three (3) or more reining classes at any show. (Once you have won 3 classes you are no longer eligible for Green Rider). Horse can be ridden one or two handed in any NRHA approved bit, but must remain consistent throughout the whole pattern or a score of zero (0) will be given. VRHA modified pattern will be ridden. One Horse/rider combination; riders cannot compete more than once in the same class on the same day and one horse cannot be ridden more than once in the same class on the same day. Horse does not have to be NRHA Licenced and Rider does not have to NRHA Membership.

## Beginner Rider

**VRHA BEGINNER RIDER:** Open to any rider that has not won four (4) or more reining classes at any show. (Once you have won 4 classes you are no longer eligible for Beginner). Horse can be ridden one or two handed in any NRHA approved bit, but must remain consistent throughout the pattern or a score of zero (0) will be given. Rider to ride the NRHA pattern.

For 2012 riders will need to enter the Beginner VRHA/GVRHA Series class at the VRHA January & February shows, and the November final show. One Horse/rider combination; riders cannot compete more than once in the same class on the same day and one horse cannot be ridden more than once in the same class on the same day Horse does not have to be NRHA Licenced and Rider does not have to NRHA Membership.
