

NRHA OCEANIA CLASSIC EQUINE GREEN REINER LEVEL 1 & LEVEL 2



NRHA Oceania Entry Level Program - Come Rein With Us !

The Entry Level Program provides a fun, educational and family – oriented ladder of competition with an Associate Membership. Each rung of the ladder welcomes beginning Reiner's to compete with others of the same skill level while gaining more experience. In addition, an awards program recognizes riders for their achievements. An even more appealing facet to this program is that these levels do not require ownership or an NRHA horse competition license.

Entry Level exhibitors have the opportunity to discuss their run with the judges after the conclusion of the class to give them a unique learning opportunity.

There are also no fees for an NRHA Affiliate to offer these Green Reiner classes. NRHA Keeps track of Green Reiner points and awards a Montana Silversmiths buckle to exhibitors who have earned more than 350 Green Reiner points.

SHOW CONDITIONS

- Associate NRHA Membership required \$40USD.
- Standard Youth Non Pro, General Non Pro NRHA Members can show in entry level classes as long as they meet the eligibility requirements for the class
- Associate Members do not need Non Pro Declaration status but must be eligible to obtain it
- Horse ownership requirements do not apply. Horse competition license not required
- Use NRHA patterns 1-16
- The rider can choose to ride with one or two hands
- The rider can choose to perform either simple or flying lead changes
- Standard NRHA rules for legal bits and attire (long sleeve shirt, hat/helmet, boots, western saddle and western bridle).
- No Judges fee applicable to the entry
- Green Reiner Level 1 – open to riders who have less than \$200 in NRHA earnings, have less than 75 NRHA youth points and / or less than 200 Green Reiner points
- Green Reiner Level 2 – Open to riders who have less than \$350 in NRHA earnings, have less than 175 NRHA Youth points and / or less than 350 Green Reiner points
- NRHA Judges are used for these classes, They have gone through the same training and testing to be accredited as an NRHA Judge. Rules for Judging can be found in the official NRHA Handbook

GREEN REINER POINTS WILL BE AWARDED ACCORDING TO THE NRHA GREEN POINT SCALE

Number of horses to be used for computation shall be those horses actually competing, excluding the number of horses entered but scratched from competition

There is no cap on the number of points able to earned in any one class

Neither a no score nor a 0 are eligible to receive points in a Green Reiner class, however this does not alter the scale of points for placing eg: If 20 horses compete in Green Reiner 1, 1st will receive 20 points, 2nd will receive 19 points, 3rd will receive 18 points etc.

GREEN REINER AWARDS PROGRAM POINT SCALE

350 points in Green Reiner classes – Montana Silversmiths Trophy Buckle

OCEANIA AFFILIATE REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Green Reiner Level 1 & Level 2 classes (Category 10) will be offered at the Affiliate Regional Championships where the winner of each Level will be crowned the title of Green Reiner Level 1 Champion & Green Reiner Level 2 Champion with a Trophy Buckle awarded to each Champion
