

2012 VRHA END OF YEAR HI POINT AWARDS Rules & Conditions

All riders and horse owners must be financial members of the Victorian Reining Horse Association at the time of showing. To be eligible for VRHA End of Year Hi Point Awards riders must have competed at a minimum of two (2) VRHA shows during the show season and must have competed at least twice in the class for which the points are allocated. Points will be allocated at all VRHA shows. Entry Level classes are excluded from Hi Point Awards.

VRHA Hi Point winners will be determined by a score basis of 1st = 6 points down to 6th place = 1 point. Tied placings will receive equal place points.

Points will be awarded on a 'one horse-one rider' combination in the Non Pro, Intermediate Non Pro, Limited Non Pro, Prime Time Non Pro, Novice Horse Non Pro L1, Novice Horse Non Pro L2, Rookie L1, Rookie L2, Snafflebit/Hackamore Non Pro, Ladies and Youth classes.

Points will be awarded to the horse in the Open, Intermediate Open, Limited Open, Rookie Professional, Novice Horse Open L1, Novice Horse Open L2 and Snafflebit/Hackamore Open. The award will be presented to the owner(s) of record at the completion of the awards year.

Hi Point Rider will be determined by a total of all points earned throughout the season as will the Hi Point Horse. End of Year Hi Point Awards will only be awarded to those classes that were offered at a minimum of two (2) VRHA shows during the season. In the event that a final equal score results, the winner will be determined by a count back. The Hi Point year begins with the first show after the 1st January and ends with the last show of the calendar year.
